1. First white settler in the Carolina colony (1650s) **George Durant**
2. Thirteen colonies; includes Massachusetts, Connecticut, Rhode Island **New England Colonies**
3. Fees that are paid when something is shipped out of a port **Customs Duties**
4. An official document authorized by a king/queen; one was for Carolina in 1663 **Charter**
5. Hilly, marshy, and wet area in the Albemarle Sound with fresh water **Great Dismal Swamp**
6. Thirteen colonies; includes Virginia, North and South Carolina, and Georgia **Southern Colonies**
7. English explorer who traveled the Carolina colony; died in 1711 **John Lawson**
8. Royal owners of the newly-chartered Carolina colony; close to King Charles II **Lords Proprietors**
9. First official town in North Carolina (1705) **Bath**
10. North Carolina's notorious pirate; once worked as a privateer **Blackbeard**
11. English settlers fought several thousand Indians after an explorer's death **Tuscarora War**
12. Thirteen colonies; includes New York, New Jersey, and Pennsylvania **Middle Colonies**
13. A yearly property tax, expected to be paid by the settlers **quit-rent**
14. Law-making body of representatives from throughout the colony **General Assembly**
15. English laws that determined which exports would be taxed **Navigation Acts**
16. Settlers vs. Thomas Miller/Thomas Eastchurch over the Navigation Acts **Culpeper's Rebellion**
17. Settlers vs. Edward Hyde on religion in politics **Cary's Rebellion**
18. Indian fort in present-day Greene County where a major battle happened (1713) **Fort Neheroka**
19. Jurisdiction that allowed for local government **county**
20. Brunswicktown was one of many that used or shipped tar, pitch, and turpentine for ships **naval stores**
