## **Columbian Exchange**

- Since Columbus, numerous Europeans came out to North
  America and exchanged items with the Indians
- <u>Europeans</u> gave guns, steel knives, horses, cattle, sugarcane, oranges, alphabet, Christianity, etc.
- Indians gave potatoes, maize, turkeys, fur, labor, and guinea pigs, etc.
- Diseases were exchanged, too. <u>Europeans gave</u> smallpox and the flu, while <u>Indians</u> gave polio and hepatitis
- Indians mostly lacked <u>immunity</u>, or protection, from these illnesses so they suffered from them
